GreatAuPair relies on our Sending Agents to conduct a careful and thorough interview with each applicant in a one-on-one setting. This is the best opportunity to understand an applicant's motivation for participating in the program. Please provide a detailed and honest assessment of each candidate. This information will be shared with potential host families to aid them in the selection process.


